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## **Calculus – Mrs. Jacknis**

### **Materials Required:**

Organization and being prepared for class is essential to your success. That is why these things are required and monitored.

- Notebook/Folder: You need a place to take notes and keep your homework. This must be in class every day. You also need to have blank paper in it.
- Calculator: Texas Instruments TI 83, TI 83+, TI 84, or TI 84+ graphing calculator. If you borrowed one from the school, be sure that you have YOURS at the end of this year.
- Textbook: The text will be used for homework and reference. You may leave it at home.
- Writing Implement: Always have a pencil with you when you come to math class.  
Pen is acceptable, but pencil and eraser is encouraged to keep things neat.

### **Tests:**

- Each test will be out of 100 points. You should expect 4 – 5 exams each quarter.
- Cheating/Cutting a test will result in a grade of 0.
- Students are responsible to make up any tests or quizzes that they miss.
- A **mandatory** quarterly test at the end of each quarter is given. It counts and it may replace one test score.
- At the end of the year there will be an in-class final exam.

### **Quizzes:**

- Quizzes will be given at various times throughout the year. Some will be take-home. Others will be in class, some of which are unannounced.
- The point value of the quizzes will vary.

**Homework:**

- Homework will be assigned on a daily basis.
- The homework grade will count as an exam grade and cannot be replaced by a quarter exam.
- In order to receive full credit for a homework assignment, effort must be shown.
